IMISC 2017 POSTER PREPARATION GUIDE

Posters should be mounted by authors during the morning of Wednesday 18th October and removed on the afternoon of Friday 20th October. Authors are free to use any template for design of the poster. However, the following items should be observed in the template:

- Posters must be A0 (840x1188 mm) horizontal or vertical format and printed on heavy-duty resistant paper or cardboard.
- Under no circumstances may posters contain any kind of advertising or commercial propaganda.
- Poster title must be no more than 90 pt.
- The other poster titles should be no more than 40 pt.
- Poster's author names and other information must be at least 18 pt.
- Text should not be less than 18 pt.
- The fonts and images must be legible from a distance of at least one meter.
- The header section should include the title of the poster, the institution and department name, conference logo, author names, and the date information.
- The poster can include photographs, figures, tables, charts, but the resolution of these visual elements should be high.
- A4 sized outputs of the poster can be put near the poster for visitors.

On arrival in the Poster Hall, all authors should check the exact position assigned to their poster. Please ensure that you are equipped with all necessary fixing materials (i.e. scissors, tape, drawing pins). The staff at the registration desk will be pleased to provide assistance in case of need.
